The firm's latest educational content builds on its earlier child support announcement by moving beyond general questions to address the details that influence each case. Among the factors examined are each parent's income and overall financial circumstances, the amount of parenting time each parent has, childcare and daycare expenses, health insurance and healthcare costs, and other child-related expenses that courts may consider when support is calculated.

The firm notes that no two cases follow the same path. Situations involving variable or self-employment income can complicate the process, as can changes in employment, differences in parenting schedules, and

additional healthcare or childcare needs. In these circumstances, determining support requires a careful review of the complete financial and parenting picture rather than a simple comparison of paychecks.

Jay Henderlite, managing partner at Sasso Guerrero & Henderlite, said the goal of the initiative is to help parents understand the framework behind support decisions. "Child support in Florida reflects far more than one parent's salary," Henderlite said. "Income sources, parenting time, healthcare costs and daycare expenses all factor into the calculation, and every family presents a different combination of those elements."

Henderlite added that understanding these variables helps parents prepare for both initial orders and later modifications. "When a parent's income shifts, a job changes, or the needs of a child evolve, an existing order may no longer reflect reality," he said. "Evaluating the full circumstances is the only way to reach an arrangement that serves the interest of the child."

The firm's educational materials also address when an existing order should be revisited. A significant change in a parent's income, a change in the parenting schedule, or the evolving needs of a child can each provide grounds for reviewing a current arrangement. The firm emphasizes that parents who understand these thresholds are better positioned to make informed decisions.

In addition to written resources, the firm produces a podcast, When Splits Happen, which explores family law topics in accessible terms for parents navigating separation and related matters. The podcast covers subjects that parents commonly encounter, including custody, parenting plans, and the financial questions that arise during and after divorce.
